

Mixing and Application Methodology

Vital Bon-Matt Stonewall

Solution Mixing Methodology

1. Check the application area where product is to be applied to ensure it is safe, the area is prepared (if applicable) and to establish the size in m².
2. Equipment must be serviceable, and tank must be clean (no residue).
3. Add water to application tank (fill the tank between 25% to 50% of the total volume required).
4. Add Vital Bon-Matt Stonewall to the water in the application tank (refer to the table below).

5. Fill the application tank to reach the total water volume required (refer to the table above).
6. Mix solution if required, use internal pump to recirculate briefly or stop/start watercart to manually mix. Do not leave the pump/agitator running for more than 1 minute.

Application Methodology

1. Check weather forecast. Do not apply Vital Bon-Matt Stonewall within 6 hours of a predicted rain event.
2. Do not apply to any active waterways or areas where standing water is visible.
3. Apply 1L of solution per 1m² (1L = 1m²), ensuring 100% coverage is achieved (no areas of bare soil or surface visible).
4. Allow solution to dry on the applied surface. Once cured (4 to 6 hours of daylight), Vital Bon-Matt Stonewall will not remobilise.

IMPORTANT

- In the event of a spill, stop the spill source (turn off pump/valve etc). Refer to the Safety Data Sheet. Contain the spill using a spill kit. Prevent the product from entering surface water or stormwater. Clean up the excess product with a spill kit.
- Always flush equipment with water at the end of the day to remove residual product (pumps, tanks etc).
- When Vital Bon-Matt Stonewall has been diluted with water, the shelf life of the solution will vary. Refer to the Product Data Sheet for more information.
